Maidstone Borough Council Staplehurst Neighbourhood Development Plan

Decision Statement published pursuant to Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and Regulation 30 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

Under Section 38A (4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) the Staplehurst Neighbourhood Development Plan was formally made (adopted) on 7 December 2016. This means that the Staplehurst Neighbourhood Development Plan is part of the statutory development plan for Maidstone Borough and used to determine planning applications in the Staplehurst area.

Modification to the Staplehurst Neighbourhood Development Plan

A local planning authority can modify a neighbourhood development plan for purposes such as correcting errors. A series of minor modifications have been made to the Staplehurst Neighbourhood Development Plan. The modifications are minor (non-material) and do not change the nature of the policies of the neighbourhood plan. As a result, consultation, examination, and referendum of the Staplehurst Neighbourhood Development Plan is not required. The modifications have been made with the consent of the Parish Council.

7	Page 34	Objective O1 – amend first sentence regarding access points for A229: [delete 'high street' and insert 'A229 Maidstone Road']
8	Page 36	Objective O5 – para 9.20 - add former pub [before 'Railway Tavern'].
9	Page 36	Objective O5 – para 9.22 – revised as there is now a pedestrian crossing in Marden Road. [delete 'the Marden Road and'; 'sites' to read 'site']

The opening sentence is rewritten as: <u>'In November 2016, Staplehurst Parish</u> <u>Council carried out a housing needs survey to refresh the</u> <u>findings of the previous survey in 2010. It identified a</u> <u>continuing modest local demand for affordable</u> <u>housing</u> ." The final sentence is rewritten to ensure it reflects the current Local Plan, deleting reference to the Affordable Housing Development Plan Document (2006) and inserting reference to Local Plan Policy SP20 Affordable Housing.
16	Page 61	Objective 12 – para 13.32 – added care and nursing homes [add to first sentence ' and throughout the parish in care and nursing homes'].
17		Throughout document – date of update applied; new website and contact details inserted.
