

## **MAIDSTONE BOROUGH COUNCIL**

### **Notice of adoption of the Local Development Scheme 2021-24**

### **The Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended)**

#### **Section 15**

Maidstone Borough Council is required to prepare a Local Development Scheme (LDS) which sets out the timetable for delivery of Development Plan Documents or Local Plans. The Council is currently reviewing the Maidstone Borough Local Plan (adopted in October 2017). The Local Development Scheme 2021 – 2024 sets out the remaining timetable for delivering the Local Plan Review. It also contains information and timetables for the Design and Sustainability DPD and Gypsy and Traveller DPD.

The LDS was approved by Full Council on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2021 and took effect the same day. This iteration of the LDS supersedes the Local Development Scheme 2021 – 2024 (adopted 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021).
