Dear Louise,

During discussions at the Maidstone Local Plan Examination last week, I was

peripherally involved in discussions regarding the prospects or otherwise

for development at Detling Aerodrome. This site is wholly within the AONB,

and I made clear on behalf of the Kent Downs AONB Unit that my client was

opposed to the allocation of this site and that the site would be most

unlikely to satisfy the requirements of the NPPF paragraph 116.

At one point, in Session 8, the Inspector asked me a question which I

interpreted at the time to suggest that Kent County Council had proposed the

Detling Aerodrome site as an alternative to employment development at

Waterside Park. I can confirm to the Inspector that this was not the case.

The Kent Downs AONB Unit, KCC and Natural England made a joint case to the

Waterside Park inquiry, and this included expert evidence on the

availability of alternative employment sites at the time. (Since then,

Aylesford Printworks has become available, for example.) It may be helpful

if I attach the evidence of Colin Cottage, Partner of Glenny LLP, on this

subject. You will see from the review of Alternative Sites in his section 9

that Detling Aerodrome was not considered. Kent Downs AONB Unit and, so far

as I am aware, Kent County Council have not promoted the Detling site for

major employment development.

I should be grateful if you could draw this to the attention of the

Inspector so that any possible misunderstanding is cleared up.
