Whilst Policy H6 of the Neighbourhood Plan is not precisely worded, it clearly seeks to promote a mixed development of housing and employment which has been supported by referendum. The draft MBC policy would only permit a conventional housing development at a density which would not allow for the inclusion of employment on the same site.
